Rugby padre joins moral movement

The Rev. G. M. Daneel, a Dutch Reformed Church minister at Grahamstown who has played for the Springboks in eight rugby Tests against New Zealand and in Britain, will join the Moral Rearmament Movement in Johannesburg at the beginning of July.

The Rev. Daneel, who served as a chaplain during the war, has been a minister in Grahamstown for the last eight years. He was born in Calvinia and educated at the University of Cape Town and at Stellenbosch.

He played rugby for Western Province and South Africa. In 1928 he played in Phil Mostert's team against the All Blacks, and in 1931 represented South Africa in all four tests on their British tour.

While still at university Rev. Daneel became interested in Moral Rearmament and its principles.
