**M**R. ROLAND KINGWILL of Gordonville, Graaff-Reinet, has given the entire proceeds of his wool levy to moral rearmament for work in the Eastern Cape.

He regards moral rearmament as the biggest factor in bringing about a new united South Africa.

An international team of the movement visited Graaff-Reinet for a fortnight and drew a bigger crowd in the Town Hall than any political meeting.

When Mr. Kingwill was asked why he did not give the wool levy to the National Veld Trust for soil-conservation propaganda, he said: 'Soul erosion is just as bad as soil erosion.'
