'MORAL RE-ARMAMENT IS A vital part of God's way of making Jesus Christ real and effective in modern people's lives,' said the Rev. Julian Thornton-Duesbery, Master of St. Peter's College, Oxford. 'That is what my meeting with Dr. Buchman did for me in 1923 and that is what MRA is still doing in 1966. Personal change leads on to other changes—social, racial, national and international.' He was speaking to 200 people at a public meeting entitled, 'What is Moral Re-Armament?' The meeting was called by American Rhodes Scholars.

'The chief problem of the world to-day is man,' said Rhodes Scholar Dick Ruffin, opening the occasion. 'But I do not believe that the only effective way to deal with him is to administer giant aspirin tablets to alleviate the aches and pains. We must actively seek to bring about a revolution in the human heart.'
