TWO FOR MRA TALKS IN JUNE

Salisbury, Tuesday.

A FORMER Finance Minister in the Federal Government, Sir Cyril Hatty, and the Treasurer General for the United African National Council, the Rev. Arthur Kanodereka, will be the Rhodesian delegates at a world gathering of moral rearmament delegates in Germany next month.

The men, who are accompanied by their wives, have been invited to join in the celebration of the centenary of Dr. Frank N. D. Buchman's birth.

Dr. Buchman, who died in 1961, was the founder of moral rearmament in Freudenstadt, near Frankfurt, where the celebrations will be held on June 4.

It was in 1938 that the Lutheran Minister had the thought (while walking through the famous Black Forest outside Freudenstadt) that what the world needed was a moral and spiritual rearmament at a time when countries were rearming for war.

The doctor of theology felt he could help change the world for the better by changing people. The root problem facing mankind revolved around human nature, he said.

Mr. Kanodereka has been invited to give the sermon to mark the centenary.

The Press officer for the movement in Rhodesia, Mr. A. Stallybrass, said: "This is quite an honour for Rhodesia and it is significant that the Germans invited the reverend because they felt the world was no longer just Europe and that they needed 'the voice of Africa at the celebrations.'"
