LONDON, Wednesday.
THE Reverend Arthur Kanodereka, who has been arrested a number of times in Rhodesia has said in London that he is optimistic about a peaceful settlement in Rhodesia.

Mr Kanodereka, Methodist minister in charge of the Harare Circuit, Salisbury, was addressing a Moral Re-Armament Conference.

"I have been an extremist," he said. "I thought the only language the White man needed was the gun.

"But the idea of Moral Re-Armament has appealed to me more than anything else. At the eleventh hour I feel very strongly that Black and White in Rhodesia can sit together under the guidance of God."

Mr Kanodereka said he was hopeful that, even if the politicians failed, a grassroots movement "could shake and change the things that are wrong in the country."

"I have been selfish," he added. "I only loved Africans and hated Whites.

"I have a lot of things to put right."
